WAIVER OF NEGLIGENCE & COMPLETE RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I wish to participate in the Kidney March which I understand to be a three-day, non-competitive pledge walk and related events, including but not limited to training club walks. I understand that by participating in the Kidney March, I will be using public streets and facilities where many hazards exist and I am aware of and appreciate the risks which may result. I am also aware that accidents can occur and that I may be seriously injured or killed as a result. I am voluntarily participating in this event with knowledge of the dangers involved and I agree to accept any and all risks of injury or death.

In consideration for being permitted to participate in the Kidney March, I agree to assume all risks and to release and hold harmless The Kidney Foundation of Canada, the city of Calgary, the Alberta Department of Transportation, their affiliated organizations, designated beneficiaries, sponsors, officials, participating clubs, communities, organizations, friends of the Kidney March and all other government or public entities (and all of their respective officers, directors, agents, employees and members) who, through negligence, carelessness or any other cause, might otherwise be liable to me.

I intend by this Waiver and Release to release, in advance, and to waive my rights and discharge all of the persons and entities mentioned above, from any and all claims for damages for death, personal injury or property damage which I may have, or which may hereafter accrue to me, as a result of my participation in the Kidney March, even though that liability may arise from negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities being released, from dangerous or defective property or equipment owned, maintained or controlled by them or because of their possible liability without fault. I understand and agree that this Waiver and Release is binding on my heirs, assigns and legal representatives.

I am physically capable of participating in the Kidney March, and my medical care provider has approved my participation. If I am aware of or under treatment for any physical infirmity, ailment or illness, my medical care provider knows of and has approved my participation in the Kidney March. I acknowledge that I, and I alone, am solely responsible for my personal health and safety, and the personal property I bring with me. I will read the Kidney March description and rules for participation in the Kidney March and I will abide by all rules and regulations established by the Kidney March organizers and personnel as well as the Alberta Vehicle Code.

I understand that my name, photograph, voice or likeness may be used by the Kidney March and The Kidney Foundation of Canada, and their licensees, affiliates and employees. I consent to and authorize, in advance, such use and waive my rights of privacy I have in connection therewith.

I have carefully read this Waiver and Release and fully understand its contents. I certify that I am at least 16 years of age at time of the event. I am aware that this is a RELEASE OF LIABILITY and a contract between me and the persons and entities mentioned above and all of their respective officers, directors, employees, agents and representatives and I sign it of my own free will. In addition, I am aware that I will be asked to confirm my understanding of this agreement on the day prior to the Kidney March by signing another copy of this waiver, and the failure to do so will disqualify me from participating in the event without entitling me to any refund.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Kidney March is committed to ensuring that the maximum percentage of donor dollars is returned to non-profit programs. We cannot predict, however, what the percentage will be. This depends on many variables, including how many walkers participate, how much money they raise, and recruiting, logistics and event expenses.

REVIEW OF REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL MARCHERS

- You must be at least 16 years of age at the time of Kidney March.
- You must raise at least \$2200 by the deadline (or pay the balance due by personal cheque or credit card) in order to participate in Kidney March.
- You must attend a safety orientation on Day Zero - check-in day.

- ❑ **Public Speaking:** Join our Speaker's Bureau! Give presentations about Kidney March at house-parties, to employee groups, civic groups and other venues for marcher, crew and volunteer recruitment as well as fundraising and sponsorship.
- ❑ **Marcher and Crew Relations:** Take charge and work with our Marcher Services Manager and Crew Coordinator to organize marcher expo's, crew orientations, and other special activities to support our marchers and crew during the year.
- ❑ **Day Zero, Opening and Closing Ceremonies:** Start us off, or welcome us home. Volunteer for Day Zero - Kidney March Check-In Day, Thursday, September 5th, 2013. Help register participants, direct traffic or process pledges. For Opening Ceremonies, Friday, September 6th, 2013, by setting-up, providing security and traffic control and taking down set up.
